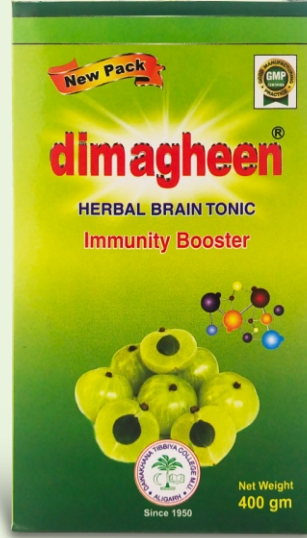

Remembering Prof. Athar Husain Siddiqi

It is with profound sadness and heavy heart that we announce the passing away of Prof. Athar Husain Siddiqi, a distinguished academic and Vice President of Ibn Sina Academy of Medieval Medicine and Sciences. He departed from this world on November 8th in Delhi, leaving a void that will be hard to fill.

Prof. Athar Husain Siddiqi was a luminary in the field of Zoology, having served as the Professor and Chairman of the Department of Zoology and as the Dean of the Faculty of Life Sciences. His contributions to the field were vast and invaluable, inspiring countless students and colleagues with his knowledge, wisdom, and dedication to the pursuit of science and society.

In addition to his remarkable professional achievements, Prof. Siddiqi was a multifaceted individual with a passion for science and literature. He authored many books in both English and Urdu. His autobiography in Urdu, titled "Main Kya Meri Hayat Kya," which was published by Alfaz Educational Book House in Aligarh in 2003. His words, no doubt, offered a unique insight into his life's journey. As we bid farewell to a distinguished educator, a prolific writer, and a cherished member of Aligarh fraternity, we remember his contributions and the indelible mark he left on our hearts. We join together in offering our deepest condolences to his grieving family particularly his wife Prof. Zakia Siddiqi (who has recently been elected as General Secretary of Ibn Sina Academy of Medieval Medicine and Sciences), daughter Taab Siddiqi and son Sohail Siddiqi during this time of immeasurable grief. His wisdom and kindness will be missed, but his legacy will continue and live on in the hearts and minds of all who had the privilege of knowing him.

Remembering Dr. Rashid Bhikha

Ibn Sina Academy mourns the sad demise of Prof. Rashid Ahmed Hassen Bhikha (popularly known as Dr. Rashid Bhikha), former EC member of the Ibn Sina Academy in the initial days! Dr. Bhikha was pioneer to introduce Unani Tibb in South Africa and Founded 'Ibn Sina Institute of Tibb in 1997'. He did his PhD entitled "African Renaissance in Health Education: Developing an Integrative Programme of Unani-Tibb training for Health Care Professionals in Southern Africa." in 2004 from the University of Western Cape (South Africa) where he also played significant role in initiating training of Unani-Tibb and a separate museum on Unani. He was a regular visitor to India and presented many papers in Aligarh as a part of MoU between 'Ibn Sina Academy' and 'Ibn Sina Institute of Tibb'.

Collaboration with Jamia Hamdard (New Delhi)

Aslam, Prof. M. Idris (Former Principal, AUTC, Karol Bagh, New Delhi), Prof. Surender Singh (AIIMS, New Delhi), Prof. K. M. Yusuf Amin (Aligarh) and Mr. Adil Khan (PRO, Ibn Sina Academy). The agreement will provide a framework of cooperation between the Jamia Hamdard and Ibn Sina Academy to further their goals, specifically with regards to health promotion particularly through Unani medicine. Both will exclusively conduct seminars/workshops/talk in collaboration in an academic year. Both the institutions shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and share all information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another.

Prof. Afshar Alam, Vice Chancellor, Jamia Hamdard, said: “The memorandum of understanding signed with the IAMMS is a watershed moment that will benefit scholars of each institution. Through our agreement with IAMMS, experts from both organizations will be able to work collaboratively to exchange information on emerging areas of research and reinforce scientific positions that will ultimately benefit not only scholars, but society as a whole. “Both organisation’s commitment to health and well-being of society at large fits perfectly with our mission. I want to thank Prof. Hakim Syed Zillur Rahman and his team at IAMMS for their efforts leading up to this historic agreement and for their commitment to promote Unani medicine.”.

Prof. Syed Zillur Rahman said partnering with Jamia Hamdard reflected the honour of Ibn Sina Academy, which is primarily working on to promote public awareness of the contributions undertaken by scientists in the field of medicine and sciences during medieval times, to preserve medical manuscripts and published books concerning history of Unani Medicine & Sciences.

Dr. Syed Ziaur Rahman (Treasurer, Ibn Sina Academy) briefed that the Department of AYUSH, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of India gave accreditation to the academy in 2004 and promoted it as

‘Centre of Excellence’ in 2008. The Academy is now a non-governmental, non-political and non-profit organization with multiple aims and objectives.

Internship Orientation Program by Centre for Studies of Plural Societies Aligarh Chapter

CSPS Aligarh Chapter organised an orientation program for the new batch of interns on 29.11.2023 at Ibn Sina Academy. Beginning with an introduction to CSPS and an overview of the internship program, the event was followed by a talk on “Social Science Research and Interdisciplinarity” delivered by Dr Irfanullah Farooqi, Assistant Professor of Sociology, South Asian University, New Delhi. The session was chaired by Dr Shivangini Tandon, Assistant Professor at the Centre for Women’s Studies, Aligarh Muslim University.

Dr Irfanullah Farooqi pointed out that disciplines play a vital role in shaping one’s thinking, but, at the same time, "disciplinisation" limits a person’s worldview. Human creativity lies beyond the boundaries created by disciplines. Dr Farooqi mentioned Donald T. Campbell’s paper, "Ethnocentrism of Disciplines and the Fish-Scale Model of Omniscience", where Campbell discusses how disciplines become restricted and self-centered. Explaining the need to counter this limitation, he highlighted Pierre Bourdieu’s idea of epistemic reflexivity. This idea means that an academic should be constantly aware of the inflexibility within their own discipline. The chair, Dr Shivangini Tandon mentioned how incorporating interdisciplinarity has affected a relatively new academic discipline like women’s studies, i.e., incorporating other disciplines like human rights, sociology, and literature with gender. As a result, only a few papers remain dealing with the core theories of women’s studies. She mentioned that it is important for a discipline to move beyond its limitations and engage in creative conversation with others for a wholesome scholarly pursuit. Interdisciplinarity provides novel ways to engage with conventional theories and the

methodological framework of one's own discipline.

In the welcome address, Dr Javed Wani, Senior Asst. Professor at Ambedkar University Delhi, explained how CSPS aims to provide a safe space for students to engage with scholars, understand concepts vital to the discourse of social sciences and humanities, and sharpen their academic skills.

Mr. Parvez Alam, Asst. Professor at Aligarh Muslim University underlined the overview of the internship program and mentioned the learning and networking opportunities, training in methodologies, knowledge production dynamics, intellectual dialogues, career guidance, and mentorship that will be offered to the students.

While introducing CSPS, Kashif Ahmad Khan stated that the centre aims to train young minds to be open to diverse ideas, frameworks, approaches, and concepts while engaging with the knowledge or its production. The centre believes that meaningful dialogue is the key to an empowered citizenry and offers training and support in a nuanced, analytical approach to scientific research on issues in a pluralistic society like India.

The program was concluded with the awarding of the "Certificate of Internship" to the first batch of research interns. Prof. Syed Ziaur Rahman (Professor of Pharmacology, JNMC, AMU & Founding Trustee of the Ibn Sina Academy of Medieval Medicine and Sciences), expressed his gratitude to the speakers.

Syed Zillur Rahman (Travelogue to Shimla)

Prof. Syed Ziaur Rahman, Hony. Treasurer, Ibn Sina Academy, has been invited as a lead speaker for a special session on Eco-Pharmacovigilance during the 22nd annual meeting of the International Society of Pharmacovigilance (ISoP) in Bali, Indonesia. He discussed the impact of therapeutic and non-therapeutic medicines on the environment and shared several case reports of the after-effects of medicines on flora and fauna. Expressing concern over the drinking water being polluted by conventional medicines, he stated that the highest cumulative active pharmaceutical ingredients (APIs) concentration was observed in sub-Saharan Africa, South Asia, and South America. In a study, 1052 sampling sites were monitored for 61 APIs along 258 rivers in 104 countries of all continents, representing the pharmaceutical fingerprint of 471.4 million people and showed the presence of contaminants in surface water that poses threat to both environment and human health. The most frequently detected APIs were carbamazepine, metformin, and caffeine (a compound also arising from lifestyle use), which were detected at over half of the sites monitored,

with the presence of pharmaceuticals in food and drinking water sources, he added.

Dr. Rahman, who is the General Secretary of the Society for Pharmacovigilance, India (SoPI), is also presently representing India for the Special Interest Group (SIG) of Eco-Pharmacovigilance as well as Herbal and TM.

“Started my association with ISoP in 2002 from Amsterdam, then ISoP at Prague (Czech Republic) in 2015, became a part of LOC_IsoP in Agra 2016 and now a guest lecture during ISoP 2023 at Bali. First time, I discussed the impact of therapeutic medicines on environment during the International Workshop on Adverse Drug Reactions & Fifth Annual Conference of Society of Pharmacovigilance (India) at Ahmedabad in 2005 and then during the 39th Annual Conference of Indian Pharmacological Society (IPS) in 2006 at Jaipur (India) where I presented a guest lecture, entitled, Pharmacoenvironmentology – A Component of Pharmacovigilance. The term, “Pharmacoenvironmentology” for the study of therapeutic drugs and its impact on environment was coined by me. Later, an editorial "Environmental Pharmacology – A New Discipline" was written by me for the Indian J Pharmacol 2006; 38 (4): 1-2. Since it was a burning topic in the discipline of pharmacovigilance, I also organised a special symposium on ‘Role of Environment in Pharmacovigilance’, during the 7th Annual Conference of Society of Pharmacovigilance, India (SoPI) at Jaipur on 25.11.2007. Now this discipline is better known as Ecopharmacovigilance (EcoPv) internationally and discussed in a special session during ISoP 2023”.

The two-day International Annual Conference on "Alternatives to Animal Experiments" and the 6th Annual Meeting of the Society for Alternatives to Animal Experiments-India (SAAE-India), organized in collaboration with the Department of Pharmacology, J.N. In his address, Prof. Gulrez stressed the need for simulation exercises of animal experiments in-vitro and ex-vivo, while pointing out that the study of the pre-clinics I testing does not

The Central Council for Research in Unani Medicine (CCRUM) is an autonomous organization under the Ministry of AYUSH, Government of India. It was established on 30 March 1978; however, it started functioning in January 1979. Since inception, the Council has been busy in researching various fundamental and applied aspects of Unani Medicine. Over the years, the CCRUM has emerged as the world-leader in the field of research in Unani Medicine.

THE NETWORK

The CCRUM has 23 research centers functioning in different parts of the country, besides its headquarters in New Delhi.

AREAS OF ACTIVITY

The Research Programme of the Council has four major components:

- Clinical Research
- Drug Standardization
- Literary Research
- Survey and Cultivation of Medicinal Plants

MAJOR ACHIEVEMENTS

Some of the significant achievements of the Council are as follows:

Clinical Research

- Developed 27 Unani drugs, which are purely natural, standardized and without any side-effects, for successful treatment of vitiligo, sinusitis, infective hepatitis, eczema, filariasis, malaria, rheumatoid arthritis, bronchial asthma and some other common ailments.
- Obtained 15 patents on for developing certain novel therapeutic compositions and SCAR primers.



Drug Standardization

- Developed pharmacopoeial standards for 298 single and 150 compound drugs. Besides, Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) for manufacture of 50 compound drugs have also been finalized.
- Published six volumes of *National Formulary of Unani Medicine*, six volumes of *Unani Pharmacopoeia of India* (UPI), Part 1 (on single drugs), and three volumes of the UPI, Part 2 (on compound drugs).

Survey and Cultivation of Medicinal Plants

- Collected over 104,568 specimens of medicinal plants belonging to 1,800 species from the wild.
- Undertaken successful cultivation of 33 important medicinal species.
- Gathered and documented over 16,261 folk medicinal claims.

Literary Research

- Translated 56 volumes of 21 classical books/manuscripts from Arabic/Persian into Urdu and other languages.
- Prepared a database of 2,400 manuscripts of Unani Medicine.
- Reprinted over 70 rare classical books.
- Compiled Standard Unani Medical Terminology for 4,028 terms of Unani Medicine.
- Developed 'Standard Unani Treatment Guidelines for Common Diseases'.

Publications

- Produced over 2,000 research papers and brought out about 400 publications, besides regular publication of a quarterly bulletin *CCRUM Newsletter*, quarterly Urdu Journal *Jahan-e-Tib* and quarterly English Journal *Hippocratic Journal of Unani Medicine*.
