Our scholarships, some of which are named in honor of distinguished alumni or teachers, are designed to ensure that deserving students can continue their education.

These initiatives aim to empower young individuals by removing financial barriers to education, providing access to resources, and nurturing personal growth through mentorship.



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## → Our Mission:

We are committed to ensuring that no student drops out of AMU schools due to a lack of financial resources or guidance. We offer scholarships and mentorship to support students both academically and personally.

## → Our Goals:

- Scholarships: Offer Merit-cum-Means scholarships to deserving students.
- Mentorship: Support first-generation learner by providing them with guidance and mentorship.





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## Programme Updates for Academic Year 2023-2024

- 1.**Scholarships:** 434 students received financial aid through our scholarship programme.
- Total scholarship distribution amount was approximately INR 25,22,080
- 2.**Mentorship:** Regular mentorship sessions are held with students via Zoom meetings, providing academic and personal guidance.We have a 8 mentor groups with 20-25 students in each group from middle to senior school.
- 3.**Books and Supplies:** Textbooks and school bags were distributed to all students to ensure their learning needs were met.
- 4.**School Uniforms:** School uniforms were distributed to many students.

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## **Selection Process:**

- 1. **School Nominations:** School principals provide a list of students who are at risk of dropping out due to financial difficulties.
- 2. **Interview Stage:** A local scholarship committee conducts interviews in Aligarh to shortlist candidates at Ibn Sina Academy.
- 3. **Final Selection:** After thorough verification of financial needs, the final scholarship recipients are selected.
- 4. **Direct Support:** Scholarships are directly paid to schools and students receive books and uniforms through contracted vendors.

Through SSGE, we strive to build a brighter future for AMU students by breaking the barriers of financial constraints and providing essential academic support. Together, we can make sure no dream is left behind.



1. Title: Reuse of coal ash for metal recovery.

Project Leader and students: Dr. Mohammad Zain Khan, PhD (Department of Industrial Chemistry, AMU, Aligarh) will guide Insha Parvez of class IX, Ms. Ilma of class IX and Ms Tashifa of class VII of AMU Girls Schools, Aligarh.

Requested Budget: INR. 20,000/- (Coal ash, chemicals, honorarium for scholar, stationary, safety tools etc.)

2. Title: Treatment of Sewage Water by macrophytes.

Project Leader and students: Dr. Umer Mujtaba Khan (Department of Civil Engineering, Aligarh Muslim University, Aligarh) supervising Uzalfa Sherwani of class VII, Tehba Sajid of class IV and Adbia Meraj of class VI of AMU Girls School, Aligarh.
